Liberalization measures under the CEPA Amendment Agreement

1. To allow Macao permanent residents who have acquired a medicine and surgery degree or above from the Macau University of Science and Technology to sit the Mainland's qualification examination after they have completed one-year internship and have become legally eligible to practise in Macao, or after they have completed one-year uninterrupted internship under the supervision of a practising doctor in a Tier 3 (tertiary) hospital and passed an assessment. A "medical practitioner's qualification certificate" of the Mainland will be issued to those who pass the examination.
2. To allow Mainland, Hong Kong and Macao recent nursing graduates, whose degrees were obtained in Macao, to sit the national nursing qualification examination with the proof of graduation issued by the institution from which the degree was obtained.
